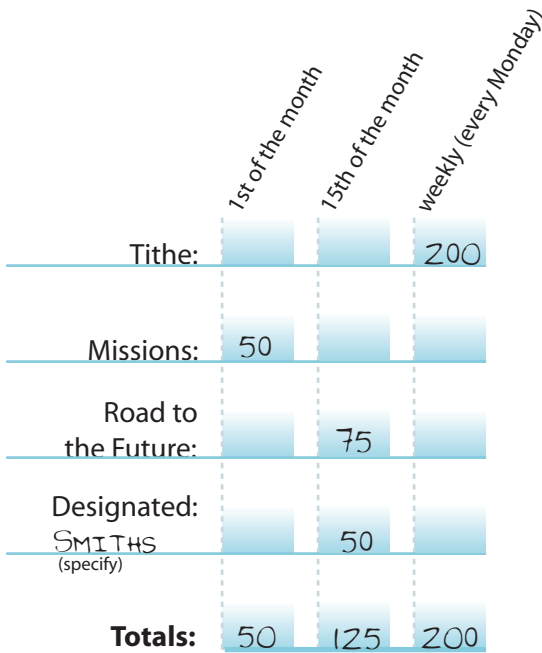

Example: I am paid on a weekly basis and want to make the following contributions:

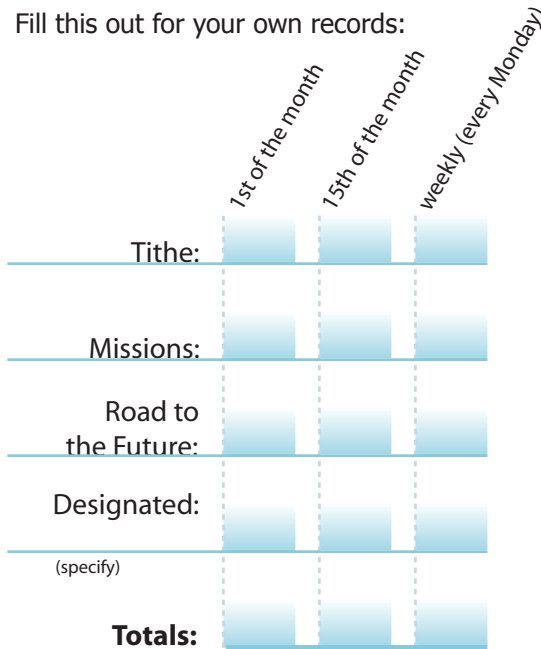
- \$200 each week for tithe

eGiving

eGiving is a time-proven, secure method used by churches around the country to receive tithes and offerings. Your tithe can now be automatically deducted from your bank account. You specify the amount and frequency of the transaction, while your contribution records are automatically updated for you. It's both worry and hassle free! Tithe by eGiving (Electronic Funds Transfer)

We now have the ability for you to give using Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). True first-fruits giving can be achieved through EFT. The name sounds complicated but the process is actually very simple and easy to begin. EFT is simply giving the church permission to withdraw funds from your bank account on a weekly, bi-monthly, or monthly basis. This amount will then be posted to your contribution record.

Just think, you no longer need to remember to write a check as you hurry to get ready for church. And if you're out of town, you don't have to remember to turn your tithe in early because it will automatically be deducted and posted to your contribution record. This is a time-proven, secure method used by churches to receive tithes and offerings.

eGiving FAQs

1. How do I sign up for this method of giving my tithe?

Sign up by completing the form on the back of this brochure and placing it in the donation box in the Welcome Center, in the offering plate or mailing it to:

2. How soon will this new process take effect?

We can begin debiting your account starting the first day of the next month.

3. How will my bank know when to transfer the funds?

We will send a file to your bank requesting the transfer of funds. The record of the transfer will appear on your bank statement as a debit from "West Park Baptist Church."

4. Will I continue to get a statement showing my donations?

Yes, you will continue to receive your giving statements from the church reflecting all of your eGiving contributions.

5. How secure is this method of collecting my tithe?

This method of transferring funds has been available to companies and churches for many years and is completely safe. Your account information is kept completely confidential.

6. Can I use this for one time contributions and special offerings?

No, eGiving is designed for ongoing scheduled giving. Please use the special offering envelopes provided by the church for one-time contributions.

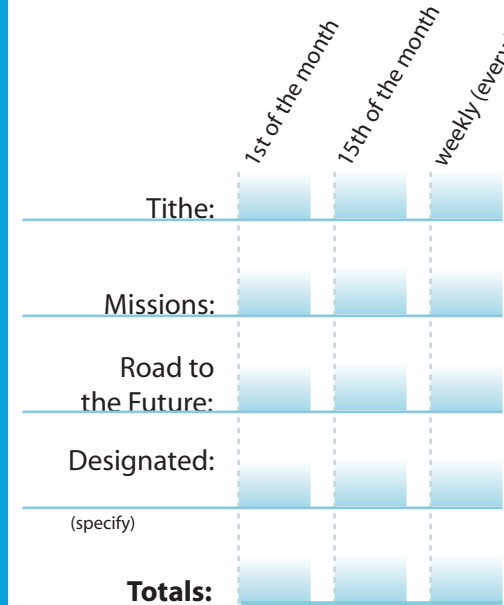
7. How do I make changes or cancel my contributions?

Simply notify the church office in writing. You can obtain a change or cancellation form online at the church website. Please allow 7 business days for your changes to take place.
